## Power Outages

If the power happens to go out or surge so will the hot water. When the power comes back on, it is necessary to go to the upstairs bathroom of both houses, press the on switch for the gas hot water panel and press the temperature arrows up or down until the temperature reaches 50 degrees.

## Stereo & Sound System Instructions

This is a very straightforward system with 4 main zones, clearly labeled above the light switch panel in the main living room. There is a docking station for ipod use and a CD player.

## Water

All of our water is filtered to 1 micron to ensure perfect quality and taste and is extremely safe to drink. Our fridges are equipped with water and ice dispensers for your convenience.



## *Smoking*

Kauri Springs Lodge is a “smoke-free” environment where possible. Smoking is not permitted inside the Lodge House or Guest House. For those who wish to smoke outside we have provided plenty of ashtrays in the outdoor seating areas. Please do not deposit used cigarettes in the garden or anywhere on the premise except the ashtrays provided.

## *The Jacuzzi (Spa)*

For the health and safety of our guests the Jacuzzi water is replaced prior to each new group of guests.

There is an outside shower located next to the Jacuzzi with hot and cold water; it is recommended that you shower before entering the Jacuzzi to assist us in keeping the things as hygienic as possible and the water in peak condition.

It is essential that when the Jacuzzi is not in use, that the cover goes back on.

In the interests of safety, children must be supervised at all times.

## *Glassware*

We have provided good quality plastic glasses for use around the property and Jacuzzi areas (purely as a safety measure). If you bring or provide any of your own glassware you must not use these in or around the Jacuzzi area. We thank you for your cooperation in this regard.

## *Fireplace*

It is essential to keep the chocolate weave furniture away from the fire. These chairs are made from materials which do not handle high heat and therefore are best kept well away when in use.

## *Household Rubbish*

There are Auckland City Council rubbish bins located outside.

- Blue bin for recycling (paper rubbish, glass bottles, plastic bottles and cans only).
- Red bin for general waste.
- Newspapers can be recycled as fire starters. Please place in basket next to the fireplace.

An internal rubbish bin is located under the kitchen bench. Spare white rubbish liners are located in the same cupboard or in the draw opposite.
